




(Friday is a make-up Winter Activities Day.)



# BVS welcomes back Children's Stage Adventures!

Mrs. Avery challenged 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade to build something with 100 Legos. The results were cool!




1<sup>st</sup> Graders worked with the number 100 all day, wearing 100<sup>th</sup> Day t-shirts, stacking cups...



...counting out stickers by tens...




...and coming up with 100 Reasons they LOVE 1<sup>st</sup> Grade.



## ROCKS Celebration


