



One effective way to encourage great behavior is to recognize that great behavior often. Our R.O.C.K.S. program is intended to do just that. Teachers and staff write out R.O.C.K.S. links to thank and recognize students for exhibiting Responsibility, Outstanding Attitude, Citizenship, Kindness, and Self-Direction. The links are then read (on the PA system in the morning or at lunch) for the whole school to hear. In just a week, we've already had two Rs, two Os, six Cs, six Ks and one S recognized. After they're read, the links will be made into a chain and hung in the cafeteria. We look forward to celebrating your Bath Eagles. Ask yours what they know about R.O.C.K.S!
